




IN MEMORY OF SUE BOLIN

Crumpet blossomed under their care and became the love of their lives.

Sue and Jerry had many pets during their 62 years together, but they came to know and love Cavaliers for their sweet dispositions and loving natures. Sue told everyone she knew about GCCR's mission to help abused, abandoned, and otherwise endangered Cavalier King Charles Spaniels. She had wonderful things to say about GCCR volunteers and she loved attending the annual Jingle Pawty with Jerry and Crumpet.
